## SERIES 2: CENTRAL REGISTRY FILES - INTRODUCTION

The files in Series 2 span fifty-two years and a wide range of subjects. These files were sent to the Public Archives of Canada with other central registry files in 1959 and 1968 (see introduction to Series 1). They were returned to the Yukon Archives and not included in RG 91 or micro-filmed because they contained exempted records and other material not considered to be of significant national importance. The files in this series are however very interesting to those pursuing the study of Yukon history.

Subjects found in the files of this series include: estate files, files on the insane, appointment of government officials, criminal, civil and Gold Commissioner court cases, applications for land, adoption of children, sternwheeler taxes, forest fires in the Yukon, dental registration, road maintenance and crews, building maintenance, government directives, letters of credit, Yukon Territorial Government financial estimates, information on government employees, liquor licenses, information on individual companies, mineral claims, Dawson Coat of Arms, taxes, schools, Ogilvie Bridge, World War I, American Women's Club, fur farms, elections, U.S. Geological Survey, information re: war veterans, Western Labour Board & International Labour Conference, family allowance payments, unemployment insurance, Air Transport Board, Whitehorse playgrounds, sanitary inspector reports as well as other miscellaneous files.
