80/46 #1	Stern paddlewheel river steamers [sternwheelers] after being pulled out of the Yukon River for the Winter - at Whitehorse. [same as 87/52 #4, which is an 8"x10" print] - 1942.
80/46 #2	Indian Spring "Beaver Camp": beavers on frame, also squaw fleshing hide.
80/46 #3	Snow plow cut on White Pass.
80/46 #4	White Pass trestle
80/46 #5	HBC fur scow. Charlie MacDonald on "Sweap", and other Tahltan Indians poling load of furs on Dease River from Lower Post to Dease Lake. - 1925.
80/46 #6	[Hydraulic mining operations, Dominion Creek.] [Same as 87/52 #1, which is an 8"x10" print] - ca 1930.
80/46 #7	[Hydraulic mining operations, Dominion Creek.] [Same as 87/52 #2, which is an 8"x10" print] - ca 1930.
80/46 #8	[Hydraulic mining operations, Dominion Creek.] [Same as 87/52 #3, which is an 8"x10" print] - ca 1930.

80/46 #12	Carmacks Store, Winter - where we stayed 3 days on trip Whitehorse to Frances Lake, 1928: Dan Snure (trader), Syd (age 3), Joyce. [Taylor, Drury, Pedlar + Co. General Store] - 1931.
80/46 #13	Steamer "Casca" at Whitehorse, Yukon Territory - 1929 or 1930.
