FONDS DESCRIPTION

WHITEHORSE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE FONDS. — 1936-2000

Physical Description:

18.7 m of textual records and other material.

Administrative History:

Administrative Structure: The Whitehorse Chamber of Commerce was founded in 1947 under the name Whitehorse Board of Trade. It was created as a means to promote and improve trade and commerce, and the economic, civic, and social welfare of the people of the Town of Whitehorse. The main objectives of the Board were as follows: to promote the Yukon's tourist trade through publicity; assist the mining industry; increase accommodation to visitors; provide answers to inquiries from tourists, business, and employment seekers; to promote roads and parks; and to improve education and postal facilities. It attempted to achieve these objectives through a program of exhibitions, publicity campaigns, civic improvement projects, and community activities.

A wide range of business and economic interests were represented in the Board, with a membership composed of local citizens drawn from the commercial, industrial, mining, agricultural, and volunteer sectors. It was a volunteer organization managed by a volunteer board which was elected yearly.

Names of Corporate Bodies: In 1964, following a trend across Canada, the Board of Trade changed its name to the Whitehorse Chamber of Commerce. The organizational structure remained the same. As a Yukon Chamber of Commerce did not exist until the 1980's, the Whitehorse Chamber of Commerce often represented business interests for the whole Territory instead of solely for Whitehorse.

Names of Chief Officers: Since inception, most of the Chamber's work was accomplished through committee work. Some of the more important committees were: Tourism; Government Affairs; Policy; Commercial, economic and industrial; Downtown development; Education; Civic Action; Transportation; and Pipeline. In 1975, the Chamber hired their first paid office manager. This enabled them to become involved with issues in a more substantive way. The office manager was able to prepare briefs, submissions, and interventions for the Board's approval.

Other Information: As the Government of Yukon became more involved in tourism marketing, the Chamber was relieved of some of the duties it had held for years. The Chamber was able to focus more on being the spokesperson and lobbyist for the business community to all levels of government. It continues to manage the Visitor Information Centre and answer written tourist inquiries. The Whitehorse Chamber of Commerce has played a major role in the economic development of the Yukon. Its representation of a diversity of business concerns enabled the group to have significant input into the inception and realization of numerous commercial projects and plans. Its participation in and sponsorship of conferences and congresses has enabled the Chamber to influence and shape the economic growth of the Territory. On the national scene, the Whitehorse Chamber of Commerce is a member of the Canadian Chamber of Commerce. One of the founding members of the Whitehorse Board of Trade, Rolf Hougen, went on to become the President of the Canadian Chamber of Commerce in the late 1980's.

Scope and Content:

The fonds consists of the Chamber of Commerce's administrative and operational files which include minutes, committee, research, subject, membership, and conference files. It also includes a small number of photographs relating to Chamber activities or issues of interest as well as maps and plans of Whitehorse, a promotional video on Yukon business, and published reference material. Also included are the minutes of the Minutes of the first meeting of the Yukon Tourist Advisory Council on November 39,

1964 and one poster titled "Shop in Whitehorse: Buying Locally Makes a Difference". The records are arranged in the following series: Administrative and Operational Records; Miscellaneous Photographs; Whitehorse Plans and Miscellaneous Maps; Promotional Video; Miscellaneous Sound Recordings; and Published Reference Material.

SERIES I - ADMINISTRATIVE AND OPERATIONAL RECORDS. –1936-1984. –

6.5 m of textual records.

This series consists of the administrative and operational files kept by the Whitehorse Board of Trade, and when it changed its name in 1964, by the Whitehorse Chamber of Commerce. The records are mostly correspondence and subject files that contain information on the projects that the Chamber was involved with over the years. These projects are: management of Robert Service Park and Campground; taxation of northern benefits; Northern Resources Conferences; Northern Canada Power Commission; Yukon Trade Show; Yukon Business Directory; administration and renovation of the T. C. Richards building; pipelines; and tourism.

The majority of the files date from the 1970's and early 1980's; however, some early files do exist. To understand more of the organization's history, consult the scrapbooks, minutes, and the Whitehorse Chamber of Commerce newsletters.

The Chamber appeared to keep their files arranged alphabetically by file title; however, over the years, some files were misfiled. The files were placed back in order by file title. Four of the five accessions included textual material and each has a file list. The file list in this inventory is a combination of all accessions and is arranged as such only on paper. All records have been retained physically separate. All original file titles were retained. When a file title did not exist, one was supplied by the archivist and identified by square brackets []. The files are listed alphabetically by file title. In those cases where more than one file has the same title, they are arranged chronologically from earliest to latest.
