## SERIES 4: CENTRAL REGISTRY FILES – INTRODUCTION

Series 4 files were stored in the Records Centre in the basement of the Casca building in Whitehorse before being transferred to the Yukon Archives in 1976.

This series of files was probably brought to Whitehorse in 1953 when the government moved from Dawson. Some may have been renumbered on arrival as many files bear what is probably an old central registry number as well as a number from a new filing system.

Some of the subjects included in this series are: information on schools in the Yukon Territory, trading post permits, Yukon Council correspondence, Yukon Council Journals, Yukon Council elections and petitions, Yukon Territorial Ordinances, road maintenance, Whitehorse and Keno City assay offices, Whitehorse Board of Trade, hospitals, information on Conrad, game management files, information on individual companies, voters lists for Yukon Council elections, appointment of government officials, tax lists and assessments, mineral claims, Moose Hall - Dawson, statistics - Dawson, scarlet fever, liquor licenses, estates, wood contracts, child welfare, family allowance, unemployment insurance, Workmen's Compensation, plebiscite re: Whitehorse Incorporation, business licenses, Yukon Government invoices, and other miscellaneous files.
