General Terms and Conditions of Permit

1. Mooring at the site shall be by means other than anchoring to or tying off to the wreck.
2. Permit holder shall ensure that there is no alteration or destruction of the wreck or removal of artifacts from the wreck and surrounding lake bed.
3. Practice a leave no trace principle for any shore based activity associated with your site visit.
