ENTRY FORM AND GUIDELINES

Who Can Enter?

Young people 18 years of age or younger who want to share their art with schools and the public around the Yukon

Anyone enrolled in a public school system in the Yukon and Stikine School District is eligible. The following categories have been established:

1. 6 years and under
2. 7 – 10 years
3. 11 – 14 years
4. 15 years and over, enrolled full-time in high school

Works That Will Be Accepted:

1. Paintings or drawings (any medium), original prints, photographs and collages.
2. 3-dimensional works not bigger than 12 x 12 x 12 inches. (These works will not go on tour because of shipping safety for the art.)
3. 2-dimensional works not bigger than 24 inches x 30 inches.
4. Only works with completed entry forms can be accepted. Please carefully fill out the form as the information you provide will be used to identify your work of art.
5. Each artist may submit only one work of art which has been completed after April 1, 2007.
6. Deadline for entry is April 11, 2008.

Important, Parents Please Note:

Artwork that is entered from the school will be returned to the school for redistribution to the students unless other arrangements are made for pickup. Artwork that is entered by a student from home must also be picked up. All work to be picked up will be in the office of the Visual Arts Assistant, Government of Yukon, Department of Tourism & Culture, Arts Section at 100 Hanson Street in Whitehorse. Please call 667-8789 ahead to make arrangements.

What Works Cannot Be Entered:

1. Framed, matted, mounted or laminated works.
2. Copies of other pictures or other photos.
3. Posters or advertising art.
4. Works that are not in good condition.

How To Enter:

1. Information and additional entry forms are available from the Arts Section by calling Megan Wright at 667-8789 or toll free 1-800-867-661-0408 ext. 8789, or by writing to Department of Tourism and Culture, Arts Section, Box 2703, Whitehorse, Yukon, Y1A 2C6. Forms may also be obtained from any school in your community.

How To Send The Work:

1. An entry form must be attached with a paperclip to the back of each piece of art. Please do not use staples, glue or tape as it can destroy the art.
2. Please ensure your entry is securely wrapped to avoid damage.
3. Packages must have a return address. It is the responsibility of the artist to inform the Arts Section of any change of address. Artwork will be returned through the schools unless otherwise stated. Any 3-D artwork must be picked up at the Arts Section. Works which are not picked up after one year will be disposed.
4. Artists may mail their work or drop it off to the Arts Section if it is not being entered through a school.

Conditions Of Entry:

Every care will be taken but we can not accept responsibility for loss or damage to works submitted. Artists who do not want their work displayed at the Department of Education, to tour the Yukon or be considered for the Student Permanent Art Collection, must indicate this by checking the appropriate box at the bottom of the entry form.

Approximately 50 works from this competition will be selected for display at the Department of Education administration building. Works not included in this group could tour the following school-year to Yukon schools, including the Yukon Arts Centre Community Gallery for a period of time during the summer.

A jury of three Yukoners interested in the visual arts will choose the 50 works to be included in the exhibition. The decisions of the jury will be final. The Department of Education exhibition will be held from May to September. A general opening reception is planned for May at the Department of Education administration building.

Please note: works selected to TOUR will NOT be displayed at this reception. Student Art Tours will begin some time in October and continue through the spring of the following year.

Up to 10 works from the Yukon Student Visual Art Program that were on display at the Department of Education administration building will be selected for inclusion in the Yukon Student Permanent Art Collection. Please remember, you must check the 'yes' box on your entry form if you want to have your work considered for the Permanent Art Collection.

Cash awards will be made to artists whose work is selected for the Collection. These vary according to the age of the artist as follows: under 7 years of age - \$25; 7 to 10 years - \$50; 11 to 14 years - \$75 and ages 15 and over - \$100.

An awards ceremony for the ten works of art selected for the Yukon Student Permanent Art Collection will be hosted by the Department of Education in the fall. Date and time will be announced closer to the date. Works not selected from the 50 pieces on display at the Department of Education will be returned to the school or student after the awards ceremony in late fall. Schools sending entries are responsible for returning these works to the artists.
