# YUKON TOURISM INDICATORS JULY 2013



#### **SUMMARY**

#### **Monthly Border Crossings**

Overall border crossing figures to Yukon increased by 6% (up 4,682 visitors) when compared to July 2012. A total of 83,595 visitors were recorded crossing the borders in July 2013.

#### **Year-to-Date Travel**

Year-to-date border crossings indicated a 10% increase or 19,571 more visitors over the same time period last year. Border crossings saw a total 210,273 visitors from January to July 2013.


#### **Erik Nielsen Whitehorse International Airport**

The Erik Nielsen Whitehorse International Airport recorded a 5% decrease or 1,781 less enplaning and/or deplaning Yukon visitors, compared to July 2012. A total of 34,752 passengers enplaned and/or deplaned this July. From January to July there have been 166,090 enplaning and/or deplaning passengers; 2,485 less passengers over the same time period last year.

#### **Visitor Information Centre Statistics**

In July 2013, 74 more visitors signed in at the Whitehorse Visitor Information Centre as compared to July 2012. A total of 18,312 visitors signed in to the Whitehorse Visitor Information Centre. From January to July there have been 48,033 visitors at the Whitehorse Visitor Information Centre; a 9% increase from the same time period last year.

#### **BORDER CROSSING STATISTICS**

Visitation to Yukon increased by 4,682 visitors (up 6%) compared to July 2012. A total of 83,595 visitors were recorded crossing the borders in July 2013. An increase was recorded in private vehicle traffic of 1,123 visitors (up 3%) and motorcoach traffic of 3,559 visitors (up 10%). By origin, increases were present for U.S. citizens, Canadians and foreigners, up 3,408, 1,099, and 176 visitors, respectively.

Private vehicle traffic increased by 1,123 visitors (up 3%) compared to July 2012. By origin, U.S citizens increased 630 visitors (up 2%) and Canadians increased 689 visitors (up 14%). Foreigners decreased 195 visitors (down 6%).

Motorcoach traffic increased 3,559 visitors (up 10%) compared to July 2012. By origin, U.S citizens increased 2,778 visitors (up 11%). Canadians and foreigners increased 410 visitors (up 13%) and 371 visitors (up 8%), respectively.

#### **Port of Arrival**

When compared to July 2012, traffic through Beaver Creek decreased by 1,870 visitors (down 12%), Fraser increased by 5,801 visitors (up 11%), Little Gold increased by 407 visitors (up 7%) and Pleasant increased by 344 visitors (up 7%).

#### Same Day Travel\*

Sameday travel saw an increase of 4,668 visitors (up 10%) when compared to July 2012. Private vehicle and motorcoach traffic saw increases 949 visitors (up 5%) and 3,719 visitors (up 13%), respectively. By origin, increases were present for U.S. citizens, Canadians, and foreigners, recording an increase of 3,480 visitors (up 10%), 450 visitors (up 10%), and 578 visitors (up 14%), respectively.

### One or More Nights\*

One or more nights visitation increased by 14 visitors compared to July 2012. Private vehicle traffic increased by 174 visitors (up 1%) and motorcoach traffic decreased by 160 visitors (down 4%). By origin, U.S. citizen visitation didn't fluctuate from last July. Canadians recorded an increase of 649 visitors (up 17%), while foreigners recorded a decrease of 402 visitors (down 10%).

## **BORDER CROSSING STATISTICS**

#### Year-To-Date

Year-to-date travel has increased 19,571 visitors (up 10%) compared to the same time period last year. An increase is noted in private vehicle traffic of 9,539 visitors (up 9%) as well as an increase in motorcoach traffic of 10,032 visitors (up 12%). By origin, increases were present for U.S. citizens, Canadians, and foreigners, recording an increase of 13,668 visitors (up 11%), 3,298 visitors (up 21%), and 1,234 visitors (up 6%), respectively.
