YUKON TOURISM INDICATORS JUNE 2012



SUMMARY

Monthly Border Crossings

 Overall border crossings were on par with last year's figures for June, with 285 more visitors coming to Yukon this year. Border crossings indicate a total of 58,670 visitors during the month of June.

Year-to-Date Border Crossings

 Year-to-date border crossings (January to June 2012) indicate a slight increase in visitation over the same time period last year. Overall visitation increased by 1% (1,513 more visitors).
 Border crossings indicate a total of 111,789 visitors from January to June 2012.

Erik Nielsen Whitehorse International Airport

• The Erik Nielsen Whitehorse International Airport recorded that the number of visitors enplaning and/or deplaning compared to June 2011 was up substantially at 12.8% (or 3,326 visitors) for a total of 29,297 passengers. The 2012 YTD for January to June is up 10.6% compared to 2011 (up 12,634 passengers) to a total of 132,042.

BORDER CROSSING STATISTICS

Overall, visitation was on par with last year's counts for June, with 285 more visitors coming to Yukon this year. There was an increase in motorcoach traffic, up 3% (or 900 visitors) and a decrease in private vehicle traffic, down 2% (or 615 visitors). Increases were observed in US visitors, up 2% (or 709 visitors) and Yukon visitors, up 1% (or 56 visitors). By contrast, there were decreases in Canadian visitors, down 4% (or 203 visitors) and foreign visitors, down 4% (or 277 visitors).

Private vehicle traffic saw increases among Yukon residents, up 1% (or 56 visitors). US visitors were on par with last year's numbers, with 37 fewer visitors this year. Canadian visitors were down 4% (or 102 visitors) and foreign visitors were down 19% (or 532 visitors).

Motorcoach traffic saw increases in foreign visitors, up 6% (or 255 visitors) and US visitors, up 3% (or 746 visitors). Yukon visitation was on par with last year's numbers. Canada had a 4% decrease (101 fewer visitors).

Port of Arrival

For the month of June, Fraser was up 8% (or 2,835 visitors). By contrast, Beaver Creek was down 20% (or 2,182 visitors) as was Pleasant, down 20% (or 1,099 visitors) and Little Gold was down 11% (or 504 visitors).

BORDER CROSSING STATISTICS

Same Day Travel*

Same-day travel increased by 2% (or 814 visitors) compared to June 2011. Private vehicle traffic increased by 2% (or 287 visitors) and motorcoach traffic was up 2% (or 527 visitors). Visitation from Canada and foreign visitation were also on par with June 2011 (up 5 and 16 visitors respectively). US visitation was up 3% (or 865 visitors). By contrast, Yukon residents were down 2% (or 72 visitors).

One or More Nights*

One or more nights visitation was down 3% (or 529 visitors) in June 2012 compared to June 2011. Motorcoach traffic was up 10% (or 373 visitors). Private vehicle traffic was down 5% (or 902 visitors). By origin, Yukon saw an increase of 5% (or 128 visitors). Decreases were present among foreign visitors, down 10% (or 293 visitors), Canadians, down 9% (or 208 visitors) as well as US visitors, down 1% (or 156 visitors).

BORDER CROSSING STATISTICS

Year-To-Date

Year-to-date travel (January to June 2012) is up by 1% (or 1,513 visitors) compared to the same time period last year. Motorcoach traffic is up 7% (or 3,233 visitors). Private vehicle traffic by contrast, decreased by 3% (or 1,720 visitors). By origin, increases are present among US visitors, up 3% (or 1,887 visitors) and foreign visitors, up 1% (or 144 visitors). By contrast, Canada is down by 4% (or 301 visitors) while Yukon is down by 1% (or 217 visitors).
