YUKON TOURISM INDICATORS SEPTEMBER 2012



SUMMARY

Monthly Border Crossings

Overall border crossings to Yukon increased by 5% compared to September 2011 (1,992 more visitors). Border crossings indicate a total of 41,021 visitors during the month of September.

Year-to-Date Border Crossings

Year-to-date border crossings (January to September 2012) indicate a 4% increase (11,839 visitors) over the same period last year. Border crossings indicate a total of 307,917 visitors from January to September 2012.

Erik Nielsen Whitehorse International Airport

• The Erik Nielsen Whitehorse International Airport recorded a total of 27,792 passengers enplaning and/or deplaning, representing a 12% (2,974) increase in the number of travellers compared to September 2011. Year-to-date (January to September) enplaning and/or deplaning passengers at Erik Nielsen Whitehorse International Airport total 232,697 travellers representing an increase of 11% (23,823 travellers) over 2011.

BORDER CROSSING STATISTICS

Visitation to Yukon was up by 5% (1,992 visitors) compared to September 2011. There was a substantial increase in motorcoach traffic, up 20% (2,778 visitors) and a small decrease in private vehicle traffic, down 3% (786 travellers). Increases were observed in visitation from Canada, up 19% (584 visitors), foreign, up 18% (840 visitors) and US, up 3% (651 visitors). By contrast, Yukon travellers decreased by 2% (83 visitors).

Private vehicle traffic saw an increase in visitors from Canada, up 5% (74 visitors). By contrast, decreases were seen in foreign, down 7% (128 visitors) US, down 4% (627 visitors) and Yukon, down 2% (105 travellers).

Motorcoach traffic saw increases in foreign visitors, up 27% (968 visitors), Canada, up 25% (510 visitors) and US, up 12% (1,278 visitors). Yukon was on par with last year (22 more travellers).

Port of Arrival

For the month of September, increases were seen in Pleasant, up 14% (330 visitors), Fraser, up 7% (1,769 visitors) and Beaver Creek, up 1% (70 visitors). By contrast, Little Gold was down 13% (177 visitors).

BORDER CROSSING STATISTICS

Same Day Travel*

Same-day travel increased by 9% (2,217 visitors) compared to September 2011. Motorcoach traffic increased by 20% (2,674 visitors). By contrast, private vehicle traffic was down by 5% (457 travellers). By origin, three groups were up: foreign, up 35% (924 visitors); Canada, up 23% (494 visitors); and US, up 8% (1,171 visitors). By contrast, Yukon was down 10% (372 travellers).

One or More Nights*

One or more nights visitation was down 1% (225 visitors) compared to September 2011. Motorcoach was up 42% (104 visitors). By contrast, private vehicle traffic was down 2% (329 visitors). By origin, increases were seen in Yukon, up 16% (289 travellers) and Canada, up 10% (90 visitors). By contrast, decreases were seen in US, down 5% (520 visitors) and foreign, down 4% (84 visitors).

BORDER CROSSING STATISTICS

Year-To-Date

Year-to-date travel (January to September 2012) showed a 4% increase (11,839 visitors) compared to the same time period last year. Motorcoach traffic was up by 10% (12,101 visitors) and private vehicle traffic was on par with last year (down 262 travellers). By origin, the US was up by 5% (10,206 visitors), Canada was up by 4% (1,012 visitors) and foreign was up by 2% (622 visitors) compared to 2011. Yukon was on par with last year (down one traveller).
